Eligibility for financial support

Whether you qualify for student financial support depends on:

- your university or college
- your course
- if you've studied a higher education course before
- your age
- your nationality or residency status

Financial support available

The main student finance support package includes:

- Tuition fee loan
- Maintenance loan - full-time students only

Tuition fee loans pay for your course. Maintenance loans help with living costs (e.g. accommodation, books, bills). Loans have to start being repaid when you earn over £21,000.

Additional support is also available, including disabled students' allowance, childcare grants, parents' learning allowance and adult dependants' grant.

If you are 19 or over on the day you start your course, you may also be eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan. You can find out more about these loans at: www.gov.uk/advanced-learning-loans
